

Accommodation offer for young people who would like to spend time together with care home residents.

The care home Hørgården, the care home Jasminvej and elderly people who come to the community support centre for older people, Hørgården have a great interest in creating fellow-feelings and good everyday experiences.

We are especially engaged in strengthening the relationship between the generations.

The young people in the student housing of Hørgården therefore participate in the voluntary work with the elderly people from the local area.

We have a variety of activities and we think it is important that the volunteers participate in the activities that interest them and make sense in their own lives.

We believe in teams and partnership between the volunteers so that you are not alone in facilitating and helping with the activities.

A lot of the activities at the care home are done in collaboration with the staff.

Examples of activities and other social intercourse with the elderly people are:

- Biking in a rickshaw with 1-2 residents.
- Playing board games or cards with the elderly people in the café.
- Participating in musical activities like a choir or a band.
- Taking care of hens or rabbits.
- Participating in a bus trip to the beach.
- Assisting the residents on visits to a child care.
- Serving drinks at a harvest festival.
- Learning the elderly people to Skype, creating a Facebook account or attach a photo to an email for a grandchild.

The care home manager at Hørgården and Jasminvej, a coordinator for the volunteers and an experience employee, café employees and 3 active citizen boards are accommodating and will invite you to join the community soon after you move in.

When we work together it will be easier for us to create happiness and enhance the quality of life for both the residents and the volunteers.

A lot of great ideas and skill sets will be brought to life.

Therefore, we look very much forward to meeting all the new student housing residents.
